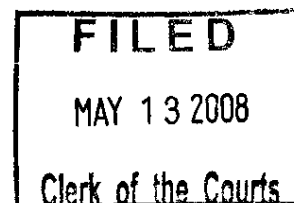

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility against the Respondent, William W. Leech; upon the Respondent's Conditional Guilty Plea and the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts the Respondent's Conditional Guilty Plea for a one (1) year suspension with all time suspended except for three (3) months and Respondent being on probation subject to the following conditions:

1. The Respondent shall extend his TLAP contract for an additional three (3) years;
2. The Respondent shall comply with any and all recommendations made by TLAP for the period of probation;
3. The Respondent shall obtain a practice monitor, agreed to by Disciplinary Counsel, who will make quarterly reports to the Board for one (1) year;
4. Respondent shall not violate any of the provisions of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct during his probation;
5. Respondent shall not violate the laws of the United States or any other state other than minor traffic violations;
6. Respondent shall maintain a good standing status regarding professional privilege tax and annual dues;

7. Respondent shall comply with Continuing Legal Education (CLE) requirements; and

8. Respondent shall keep the Board of Professional Responsibility (the Board) notified of his current business and home addresses, and telephone numbers and shall immediately notify the Board of any change in his addresses within thirty (30) days of the change of address.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT
that:

1. Respondent, William W. Leech, is suspended for one (1) year with all time suspended except three (3) months and the Respondent being on probation subject to the following conditions:

1. Respondent shall extend this TLAP contract for an additional three (3) years;

2. Respondent shall comply with any and all recommendations made by TLAP for the period of probation;

3. Respondent shall obtain a practice monitor, agreed to by Disciplinary Counsel, who will make quarterly reports to the Board for one (1) year;

4. Respondent shall not violate any of the provisions of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct during his probation;

5. Respondent shall not violate the laws of the United or any other state other than minor traffic violations;

6. Respondent shall maintain a good standing status regarding professional privilege tax and annual dues;


7. Respondent shall comply with Continuing Legal Education (CLE) requirements; and

8. Respondent shall keep the Board of Professional Responsibility (the Board) notified of his current business and home addresses, and telephone numbers, and shall immediately notify the Board of any change in his addresses within thirty (30) days of the change of address.

2. Pursuant to Rule 9 §24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, the Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$1,083.00 and in addition, shall pay the Clerk of the Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary; and

3. The Board of Professional for Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9, §18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.
